Purpose

This form collects required information to report to the IRS the taxable portion of prizes or awards/gifts paid for by the College and delivered to individuals whom are <u>NOT faculty</u>, <u>staff</u>, <u>and students of Occidental College</u>.

Take note!

Gift cards and **gift certificates** purchased with College funds and awarded to Non-Occidental recipients are considered taxable income and are subject to withholding, <u>regardless of amount.</u> The tax code is quite clear that this applies to <u>all</u> gift cards, no matter how small the value. There are no <u>de minimis</u> exceptions. Even a \$5 gift card or gift certificate is considered taxable and must be reported to the IRS!

It is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure reporting of taxable income.
