FEAST (Food, Energy, and Sustainability Team) is a student service which runs an organic garden that grows produce, raises a brood of hens, mitigates waste through composting, restores native plants on campus, hosts educational workshops, engages with the surrounding community, and acts as a teaching and learning space for issues of sustainability, environment, and food.

Duties: The Bruce Steele Garden Coordinator is responsible for being the primary caretaker of the Bruce Steele Garden. This entails several responsibilities as follows split into 3 different student workers:

Responsibilities:

- Facilitating garden space in relation to urban food systems, sustainability, education and overall productivity
- Coordinate an enriching community engagement experience, oversee the greenhouse and nursery, maintain seed collection and keep garden records
- Organizing workshops with facilities, campus dining and other Oxy sustainability groups
- Host monthly educational workshops throughout the year
