

Road to Occidental Webinar: Student Employment at Occidental

Q: My student does NOT have a work study grant, but this webinar is relevant to attend (about how to get a job at Oxy, in general, yes?)

A: Correct! There will be some information like this that is work-study specific, but there will also be information that is relevant to all students interested in campus jobs.

Q: What is the timeframe for applying to jobs? The application includes a question about availability, which would depend on our class schedules. How fast are the applications usually processed and when can we start applying?

A: Most students will apply for jobs during the first week or two of the fall semester - but you can actually apply for a job at any point in the year if it's available!

Q: My daughter will start Oxy at 17 years old. Can she work on campus as a minor?

A: Yes! That will not be a barrier for her.

Q: Will the income from student employment be taxed?

A: Yes, these jobs and positions are taxed as they are hourly positions as opposed to research stipends.

Q: How long does each HCC workshop last? I am definitely interested in attending.

A: Each HCC workshop is one (1) hour and the total time commitment is two (2) hours of professional development workshops to be eligible for the FY STEP Program.
