TIPS FOR SUCCESS

Introductions

Demonstrate professionalism with a firm handshake, good eye contact, and a genuine smile. Discuss who you are, what you do (or hope to do), and your experience/skills related to the position.

Engage in Conversation

Ask specific questions based on your knowledge of the company and information you are hearing in the moment. Have a short list of questions ready—it's an easy way to start a conversation!

Your Resume

Some employers will accept paper copies of your resume but others may ask you to apply online. Remain flexible as each employer may have its own practices.

Time Sensitivity

Be aware of how much time you spend with each representative. If there is a line, focus on your top two questions. You can always ask to connect after the fair to have additional questions answered.

Follow Up

Make note of the name of each representative you speak with. Ask for a business card and follow up after the Career Fair with a brief thank you. Additionally, you can follow employers on Handshake and LinkedIn to stay connected and up-to-date on their job/internship openings.
