# TIPS FOR SUCCESS

## Introductions

Demonstrate professionalism with a firm handshake, good eye contact, and a genuine smile. Discuss who you are, what you do (or hope to do), and your experience/skills related to the position.

## Engage in Conversation

Ask specific questions based on your knowledge of the company and information you are hearing in the moment. Have a short list of questions ready– it's an easy way to start a conversation!

## Your Resume

Some employers will accept paper copies of your resume but others may ask you to apply online. Remain flexible as each employer may have its own practices.

## Time Sensitivity

Be aware of how much time you spend with each representative. If there is a line, focus on your top two questions. You can always ask to connect after the fair to have additional questions answered.

## Follow Up

Make note of the name of each representative you speak with. Ask for a business card and follow up after the Career Fair with a brief thank you. Additionally, you can follow employers on Handshake and LinkedIn to stay connected and up-to-date on their job/internship openings.
