





HOUSING abroad/return Abroad

Choose homestay (globally most satisfied!) or **standard** only, not "premium." Singles, private bathrooms without documented accommodation – cost on YOU if these are premium.

Here -SPRING 2026 see portal:

- Students who need <u>housing accommodations or have particular housing needs or preferences</u> may be studying abroad in the **SPRING** semester.
- If you <u>study abroad in the FALL</u> semester and plan to return to live on campus for the SPRING semester, <u>you will be assigned</u>
 an <u>available room on campus</u>. There is NO Room Draw process for on-campus housing for SPRING semester, and RESED
 cannot guarantee any availability of a particular room type. Typically, rooms available for the SPRING semester include double or triple-occupancy rooms with existing roommates. If you intend to live off-campus when you return for the spring semester, you
 must engage in the third-year live-off process and receive approval from REHS to live off-campus upon your return.



Passports & Visas

PASSPORT: CHECK. RENEW. APPLY NOW!!!

 X passports Good news - X marker or those listing a sex different from your sex at birth - will <u>remain valid for travel</u> until their expiration date. Bad news - New passports/in process-"sex at birth" rule or will be returned.

VISA: You will likely need a student visa.

- Get <u>admitted to your program THEN</u> they send you detailed VISA instructions/paperwork. ***Do not delay or wait.***
- On-line (Australia, New Zealand, France, UK), or paper process.
- TAKES TIME.
- Oxy cannot control.
- Use the visa service (SIT, IES, CIEE . . .)
- Oxy certification letters in "documents," IPO portal after break.


